THINGS TO BRING TO FAMILY CAMP

modest clothes for hot afternoons and cool evenings sturdy walking shoes warm jackets and hats (there have been a few unseasonably cold Family Camps!) modest swimwear swim toys; life vests if you have them, especially for small children (we have a very limited number of children's life vests) beach towels shoes you can get wet (required for tubing in the irrigation canal) camping gear if staying in tent or RV sleeping bags and pillows (a light-weight sleeping bag liner or sheet is nice if it's hot) fan if staying in a cabin flashlights personal items/toiletries/soap/hand towel bath towels/shower items Bible, notebook, pen insect repellant sunscreen, chapstick lawn chairs camera water jugs and cups/sports water bottles high chair or booster for small children if they need them fishing gear if you want to fish (no license required)
